Workshops:

Therapeutic Dolls

These clothespin dolls can be used for a variety of therapeutic purposes; Heroine Dolls and Hero Figures for girls' and boys' groups, Inner Guide Figures for teenagers or adults, Worry Dolls for children. The workshop will briefly review various purposes these dolls can have in art therapy with different populations. The facilitator will then lead workshop participants through the making of their own dolls.

Printmaking

This workshop will review various inexpensive and easy printmaking approaches. The clinical uses and metaphors imbedded in the process will briefly be explored before workshop participants learn and practice multiple printmaking techniques. Participants will have the opportunity to create and customize multiple objects, from cards to T-shirts.

Stop-Motion Animation

Stop-motion animation can be a helpful tool in eliciting clinical information while simultaneously helping clients explore new roles and coping skills. The workshop will give case examples of stop-motion animation, go over the technical aspects, and give workshop members the opportunity to work in groups to create their own videos.
