GRADE TRACKING TIPS

Tracking your grades is the best way to stay in the know regarding your academic standing in a course. If you don't know where you stand, how will you know where to make improvements.

The course syllabus assignments page will display the total earnable points in a course.

For each course enrolled, print and use the backside of your assignments page to log and update the point value each time a grade is earned.

Subtract the total earned points ($\underline{340}$), from the lowest point value needed to earn the desired grade.

Example

To receive an A- grade in the course, one must earn a minimum of $(\underline{110})$ of the remaining $\underline{160}$ available points.
